This year the e-Piano MusikFest International will be conducted entirely online. The dates remain the same. Below are some important changes to the format and logistics of the MusikFest.

All MusikFest participants will receive 5 private lessons during MusikFest. All lessons will be conducted via Zoom. MusikFest will manage all arrangements. There will be evening performances with participants either performing live or submitting recordings to be broadcast during the recital. There will be no chamber music. Submit this application to participate in MusikFest.

MusikFest participants can participate in a MusikFest **Competition**. Competitors will have to submit a video recording of one piece that is no longer than 15 minutes (in addition to this application. Recordings will be reviewed, all competition participants will receive written comments, and up to 6 winners will be selected to take lessons with Yefim Bronfman and with Boris Slutsky. These two lessons will be in addition to the 5 MusikFest Lessons.

Technical requirements: To get the most out of the MusikFest, we ask for participants have the following:

- Reliable internet connection (wired preferred)
- USB condenser microphone. Our recommendation is Blue Yeti, Blue Yeti X, Blue Yeti Nano or comparable devices.
- Laptop (preferred) with built-in webcam or a computer with external webcam. iPads or mobile devices are possible, but will require special equipment to connect with a USB mic and we do not recommend using them.

We will conduct 30 minute individual session with each MusikFest participant to help them set up and tune their setup for lessons and performances.
